MINUTES STEERING COMMITTEE MEETING MARCH 1, 2018, 9:00 am

Bill Brown distributed the treasurer report reflecting the expenditures and income for the past month. Balance to date is \$4,181. He also said he had an audit with Ken Walters. The financial records are fine. But Ken suggested the Club do more research on implementing PayPal and determine if the membership wants to adopt this payment system. Susan will send out the audit report to all members and Bill will briefly talk about the audit at the March 5th membership meeting.

Bill also announced that Kathy Prince would like to back out of the contract for health reasons. She has a recommended a company that could take over. It would be about \$1200 a year.

Bill asked for the Committee's approval to pay \$449 to Kathy based on invoices submitted. Sandy made a motion to pay her and Susan seconded and the motion carried. Glen announced that he intended to move out of the community next fall.
