

**MINUTES**  
**SUN CITY ANTHEM HIKING CLUB**  
**GENERAL MEETING – March 2, 2020, 6:30 PM**

**Meeting was called to order by Susan Dona at 6:25 PM.**

**Hiking Report – Sedona** - Bruce O/Bill Scott

1. Hikes leave ½ hour earlier in March.

2. Drink plenty of water during the warmer weather and start at the beginning of the hike.
3. Snakes are out... watch for them. Don't put your feet or hands any place that you haven't checked out first.
4. Bees may be out. If there is an attack, run (or walk quickly) away from the source for at least ½ mile.
